This professional development opportunity is sponsored by the U.S. Embassy and hosted by North Carolina State University (NC State). The online program connects early career teachers from across Azerbaijan to English Language Teacher Trainers in the U.S.A. for 18 weeks of online instruction and practical application.



ELT Certificate Program teacher participants meet twice weekly for:

- 1. Lecture Presentation (Mondays 19:30-21:00 AZT)
- 2. Practicum Discussion (Wednesdays 20:00-21:30 AZT or Thursdays 19:00-20:30 AZT)

The ELT Certificate Program runs online from January through May 2024 with one inperson conference planned in Azerbaijan in June 2024.

Current government school English teachers can apply until December 5, 2023.

A cohort of 100 English as a Foreign Language (EFL) teacher participants will be selected for the 2024 program.

Applicants must:

- be current English language teachers (excluding teachers of other subjects who use English)
- currently work for a government school (employment verification required)
- identify as "early career" professionals (within the first 7 years of English language teaching)
- have relatively little previous experience with professional development opportunities
- · be confident with spoken and written English language
- demonstrate motivation to learn and implement change into teaching practice
