


# IMMUNIZATION GUIDELINES



# COMPLETE ALL THREE (3) FORMS

(1) Health History form, (2) the Tuberculosis Questionnaire, and (3) submit copies of your immunization records online in the HealthyPack Portal.

# NAME AND BIRTH DATE ON EVERY PAGE

Every. Single. Page. of all documents submitted



# U.S. AMERICAN STYLE DATES

Dates should be in the U.S. American MM/DD/YYYY format where possible.

## MINIMIZE UPLOADS

Consolidate all of your vaccine information into one document instead of uploading multiple documents. Do NOT keep uploading the same documents.

### INCLUDE ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS

Make sure you upload your health/baby book/original documents because there are a LOT of transcription errors on the NC State form. Dates on the original documents may be written in the DD/MM/YYYY format.


# HEALTHYPACK PORTAL

# IMMUNIZATION RECORDS COMMON ISSUES



### MMR (ROUGEOLE / OREILLONS / RUBÉOLE)

Two (2) doses are required ON or AFTER your first birthday/
1 year of age. Doses that are administered before the
student turned 1 year of age will not count. There are no
exceptions.







### TB SCREENING REQUIRED

ALL students must fill out the Tuberculosis (TB) Screening in the HealthyPack Portal. Only students from high-risk countries or recently traveled there are required to do TB testing. NC State <u>does not accept</u> PPD/Mantoux/skin tests from outside of the US. We recommend taking the test at NC State Campus Health as soon as you arrive.

### DTP/DTAP/TDAP (TETANUS, DIPHTHERIA, PERTUSSIS)

- 1) Pertussis = Coqueluche and NOT Poliomyélite. The vaccine is known as Diphtérie / Tétanos / Coqueluche (DTCaP / dTcaP) in France.
- 2) All students must show proof of a Tdap booster after the age of 12 AND within the last 10 years.

You will need another shot if your booster was 10+ years ago.





#### HEPATITIS B

Required if born after July 1, 1994. Either a three (3) dose series or two (2) doses of HEPLISAV-B series. Students could receive the first 2 doses at home (at least a month apart).

The 3rd dose must be at least 2 months after the 2nd dose and at least 4 months after the 1st dose.

### MENINGOCOCCAL CONJUGATE VACCINE (MENACWY)

Required if born on or after Jan. 1, 2003. Common names of Meningococcal ACWY vaccines: Menactra, Menveo, Menomune, MenQuadFi, Penbraya (ACWY + B), Nimenrix (France), Menpovax (Europe).









If you don't complete your health records requirements by the due date, you will lose access to NC State facilities and services and must pay a \$150 reinstatement fee.
